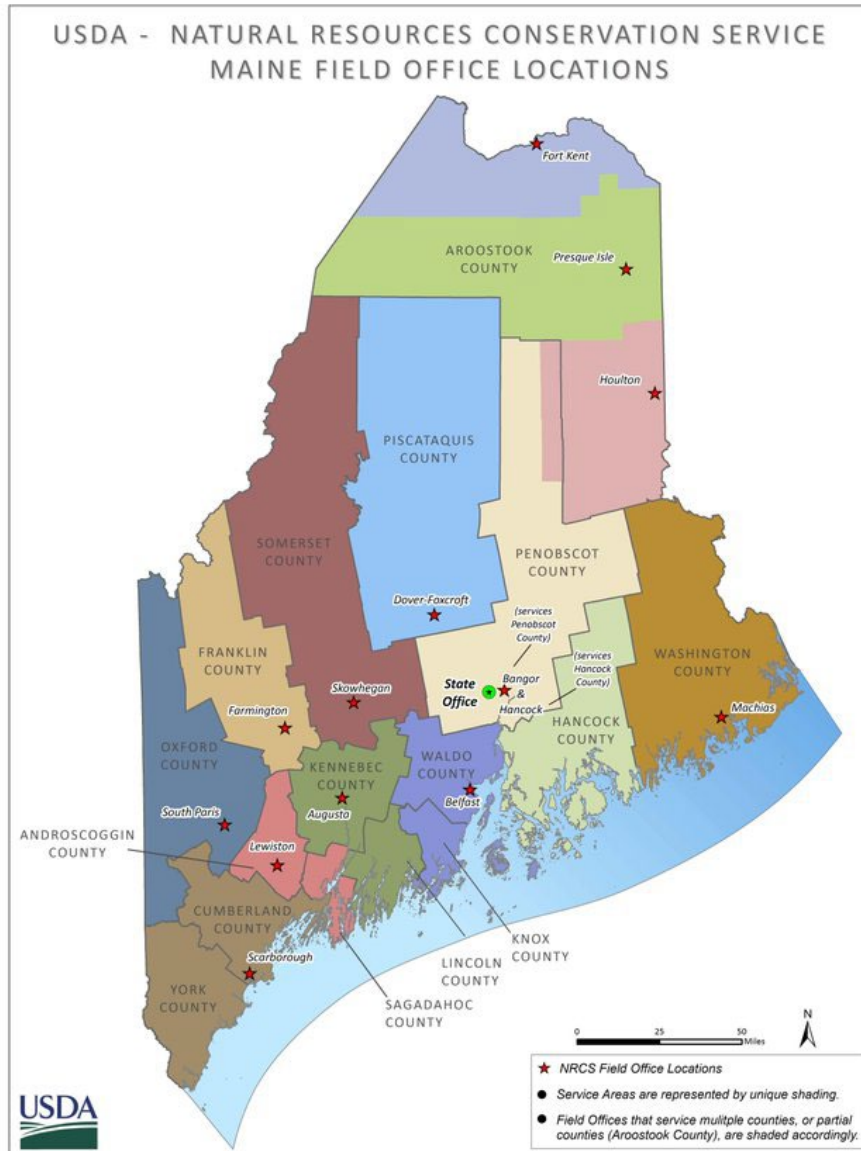

Resource Concerns

- soil, water, air, plant, energy, human, and animal
 - Aquatic Habitat for fish and other organisms
- Provide TA and FA Assistance

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Technical Assistance

- **Use science-based technology for TA and FA**
- **Conservation plan:**
 - Developed based on the landowner's goals
 - ID resource concerns/opportunities
 - Conservation practices
- **Specialists:**
 - Fisheries Biologist
 - Engineering



Enhanced Aquatic Opportunities in Maine

- **AOP and instream habitat are exempted from needing a forest management plan**
- **Multiple FA opportunities:**
 - Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP)
 - Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPP)



Financial Assistance for Aquatic Restoration Opportunities

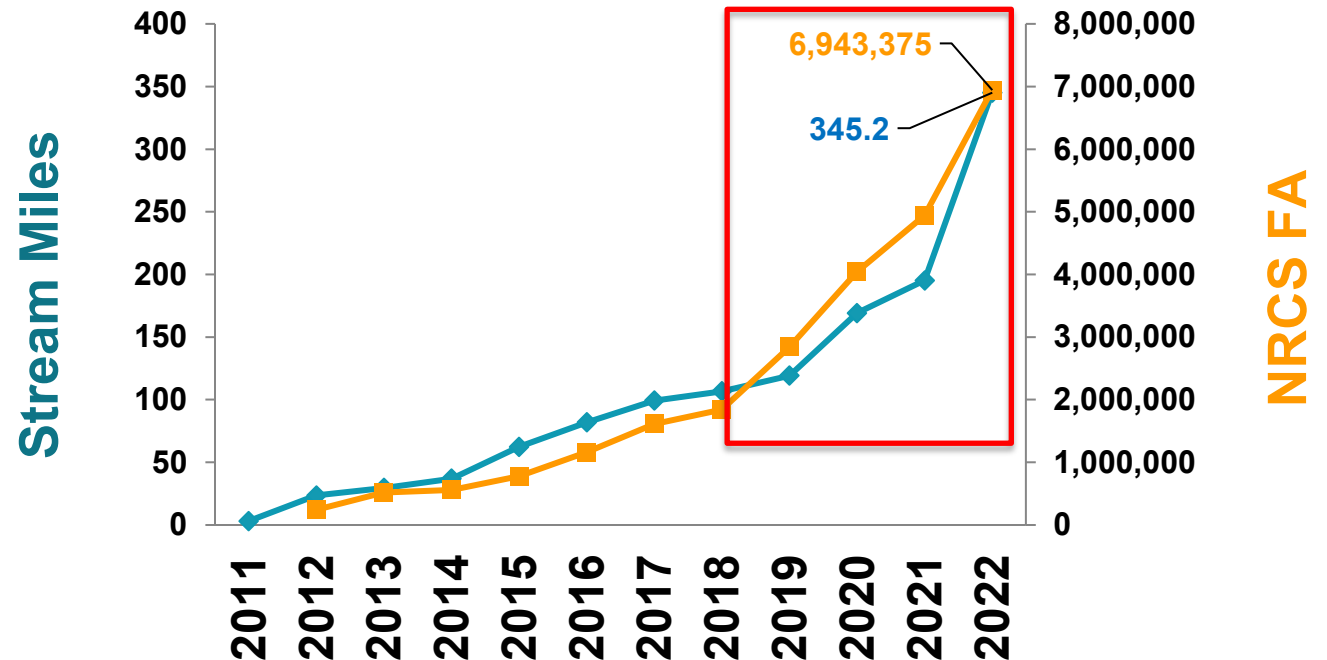
All Funding is competitive Cost Share Reimbursements Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP):

- \$450,000 cap per farm bill
- Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) cap of \$900,000

Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPP)

- NRCS works closely with partners
- Ability to work with larger landowners
- Project AGI waiver
- No Farm Bill payment limitation, contract limitation of 450,000

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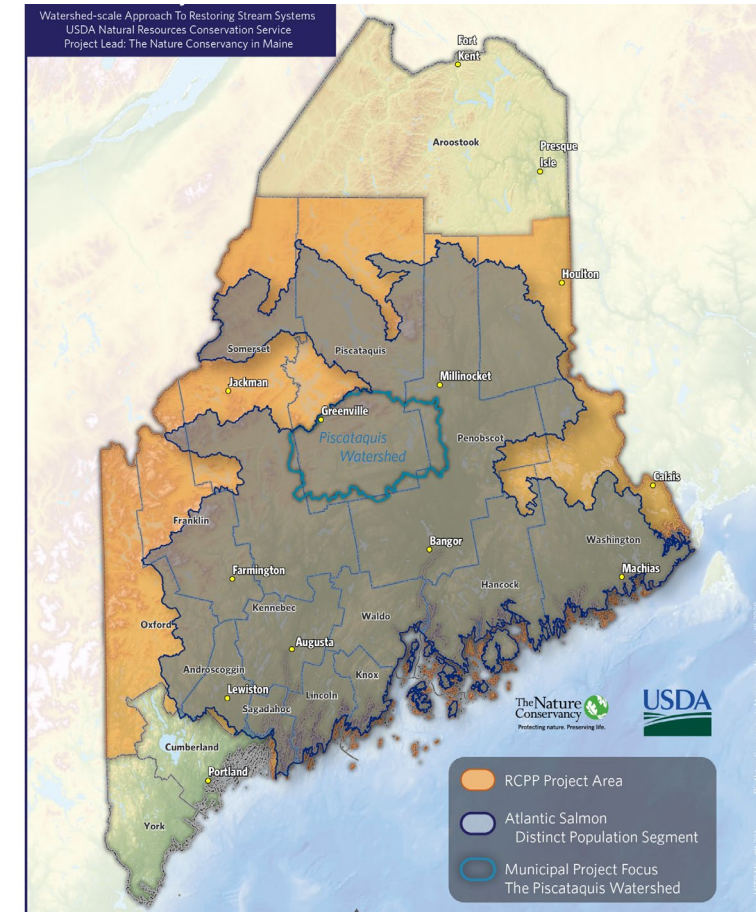
FA Opportunities for 2024

- Watershed Approach to Restoring Stream Systems, \$1,100,000



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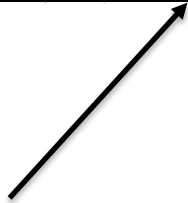
